ORCHESTRAL TERMS & REQUIREMENTS

- The Orchestra will provide the orchestral instruments and necessary players. *** subject to negotiation for percussion and large instruments, discussed on case by case basis.
- The Promoter will provide the venue(s) at its own expense, including front of house and backstage personnel (ushers, ticket takers, security guards, stagehands, box office and subscription services), for all rehearsals and concert as on the above schedule.
- The Promoter should organise Rehearsal and Concert Venue(s) (including any piano tuning, technical staff and equipment costs) at their own expense. Any rehearsal set-up should be the same as the performance set-up unless agreed otherwise.
- The venue(s) to be safe and suitable for the purposes of the engagement and comply with all applicable laws, health and safety requirements and regulations in force, including possession of appropriate licences and liability insurance cover. All fire exits should be operational and clearly marked.
- The Promoter should notify Polyarts and the Orchestra of the stage size, ideally 15 metres across and 9
 metres deep, with the ability to set specific riser heights for brass and percussion. The Orchestra must be
 provided with a stage plan at least three months in advance of the concert date. If necessary, a stage
 extension to be provided for the rehearsal and concert.
- 33-piece orchestra 22 music stands, 28 non-folding chairs (including 2 non-sloping, non-folding straight-back cello chairs, 2 height- adjustable piano stools and 1 Conductor's rostrum with back-rail and stool, to be provided at the venue(s), in addition to any requirements from the other Artists. It must be discussed separately whether the Orchestra will bring their own double bass and percussion stools.
- 72-piece orchestra 55 music stands, 65 non-folding chairs (including 6 non-sloping, non-folding straight-backed cello chairs), 2 height- adjustable piano stools and 1 Conductor's rostrum with back-rail and stool, to be provided at the venue(s), in addition to any requirements from the other Artists. It must be discussed separately whether the Orchestra will bring their own double bass and percussion stools.
- In the expected absence of white concert lighting (minimum 600 lux) to be directly overhead covering all areas of the platform, the Promoter will be financially responsible for the provision of suitable music stand lights. Please endeavour to make sure onstage lighting is not going to be in the eyes of either the Orchestra or Artists. Adequate air-cooling or heating, as required, should be provided for the duration of all rehearsals and concerts and the venue(s).
- A full-size, 9' concert grand Steinway-D piano and the services of a piano tuner to be provided for the rehearsal(s) and concert as on the above schedule. If a Steinway is not available, or if anything less than a 9' concert grand is desired, Polyarts or the Orchestra should be consulted well in advance. Piano pitch should be A=440Hz, 441Hz or 442Hz (any of the three are acceptable) but certainly no higher than 442Hz. In addition to the piano, the Promoter is responsible for providing two competent stage hands (either from the venue or from the piano company) to move the piano as required particularly on the concert day, when any stage hands should be dressed appropriately (i.e. black shirt and trousers).
- The Promoter is responsible for the provision of any PA and other technical equipment required for the rehearsal(s) and performance in consultation with Polyarts and the Production Manager for Cypress Hill.
- The exclusive services of four competent and fit stagehands (able to carry out this work with minimal risk to themselves or others) should be available at the concert venue(s) for load-in and load-out, to assist with carrying instruments. The services of a venue manager should be available from time of load-in until load-out, to assist with the adjustment /moving of stage risers.

CYPRESS HILL SYMPHONIC ORCHESTRAL TERMS & REQUIREMENTS

Secure parking for the instrument truck to be provided at the concert venue for the duration of the
entire stay. The truck may also require access to a 220-240V power supply via a 3-pin, 16-amp cable
(with the female end accessible to the truck at its parked position) for the purposes of the on board
heating/cooling system. If the truck needs to be moved between load-in and load-out.

NB: Secure parking is defined as parking in a secure compound, benefitting from a minimum 2-metre high surrounding wall or strong palisade-type fencing of same height, with secure locked gates. In addition, the site should have 24-hour CCTV recording or manned security.

- The concert venue to have secure and separate dressing rooms and toilet facilities, as well as separate rooms for the Artists as appropriate, Orchestra Leader, and Orchestra Administration, with all rooms clearly marked.
- Bottled mineral water (or water fountains) should be provided free of charge backstage for the entire
 Orchestra and Artists before, during and after all rehearsals and concerts.
- A minimum of 10 complimentary best tickets, not within the first ten rows of the Stalls to be made
 available to the Orchestra, in addition to any Artist requirements. At least two tickets to be on an aisle
 and, if possible, with easy access to backstage. These should be organised well in advance of the
 concert date and indicated on a venue seating plan to be provided to the Orchestra.
- Printed programmes and programme notes of the usual kind, with up to 20 complimentary programmes per concert available for the Orchestra, in addition to any Artist requirements.

NB: the Orchestra will be given a minimum of two working days to approve proofs prior to any print or publicity deadlines, with a schedule of deadlines to be clearly communicated to Polyarts or the Orchestra in advance.


 Additional fees will be paid in the event of radio and/or television broadcast and/or archive recordings.

EXAMPLE STAGE PLOTS


33-piece orchestra

B: Orchestra plot for 33-piece orchestra




